Grand Haven PSD Cost Analysis

Grand Haven's current annual personnel cost is \$3,325,730 for it's PSO department (information from Grand Haven's 2013 budget).

If Grand Haven were to convert back to a traditional model of separate police and fire departments they could save \$705,411 annually in personnel cost alone.

Once you add in the savings in equipment and training cost, Grand Haven could easily realize three quarters of a million dollars annually in savings, while still providing uncompromised levels of protection and service to the citizens

Grand Haven's projected annual personnel cost for separate police and fire departments is \$2,620,319 and again resulting in \$705,411 in annual savings

Staffing levels in the police and fire departments were derived by applying the same level of per capita staffing per position to Grand Haven as current levels in Marshall.
